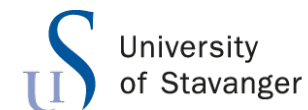


# NORSI – NORWEGIAN RESEARCH SCHOOL IN INNOVATION

- NORSI is a networked based research school that consist of ten partner institutions: BI, CIRCLE, HIL, NHH, Nord University, NTNU, UiA, UiO, UiS, and UiT. NORSI is available to PhD students accepted to an innovation-oriented PhD program at any of the NORSI institutions and other Norwegian PhD granting institutions.
- NORSI is hosted by the Norwegian University of Science and Technology (NTNU), and administered by BI Norwegian Business School. The Research Council of Norway through their Program for Regional R&D and Innovation (VRI) funds NORSI.
- NORSI – Norwegian Research School in Innovation is a flexible and complimentary doctoral program intended to strengthen doctoral students' knowledge of innovation-based research. NORSI work to enhance the innovation research education and strengthen connections in the innovation research community.
- NORSI is a flexible doctoral program developed to fit students' individual research progress and course requirements at their "home" institutions. NORSI is a research school where PhD students enroll to take courses as an integral part of their doctoral studies either from the beginning of their studies or later in their doctoral research. NORSI has continuous enrollment.



- NORSI facilitates courses and disseminate information on innovation courses and research. The NORSI courses offer an interdisciplinary and integrative approach to understanding the process of innovation, entrepreneurship and management.
- For doctoral students in innovation NORSI offers an opportunity to be an integral part of a research network focused on innovation by attending courses led by leading local and international scholars in innovation, and by meeting other innovation research students.
